

Guess the Number!

Guess the Number!



Objective: To integrate math and cardiovascular fitness in the classroom or outside.

Needed: Halloween number cards. Duplicate cards on cardstock or laminate for more durability.

Preparation: Choose one student volunteer who stands in front of the class, the rest of the class stands facing the “Guesser”.

Directions of the Game:


The “Guesser” stands in front of the class facing the students. A person/teacher stands behind the Guesser holding up a number. The Guesser yells out a number, the class directs the Guesser by guessing higher or lower by jumping in place or squatting low. The Guesser keeps guessing until the number is guessed. Only the guesser is allowed to talk! Remind children not to say what the number is or give hints to the Guesser. Begin game with a demonstration.


Suggestions: For TK or K, keep the number under 10 or 25. For 1st and 2nd graders, keep the number under 100. For older grades, any number keeps them guessing!


Variation: For older children, use a timer or stopwatch to see if they can guess within a certain time frame.

Health Connection: Have children check their heart rate periodically. If their heart rate is beating higher they are attaining moderate-to vigorous physical activity (MVPA) and their heart is saying “Thank You for making me heeaaalllthy!”


